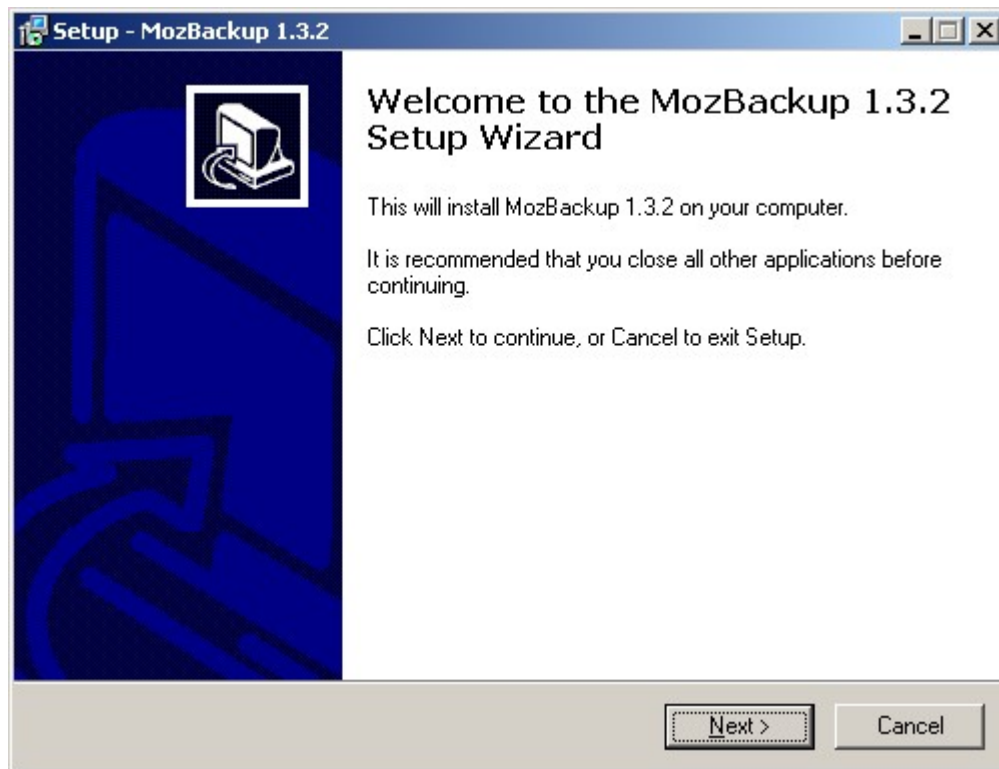
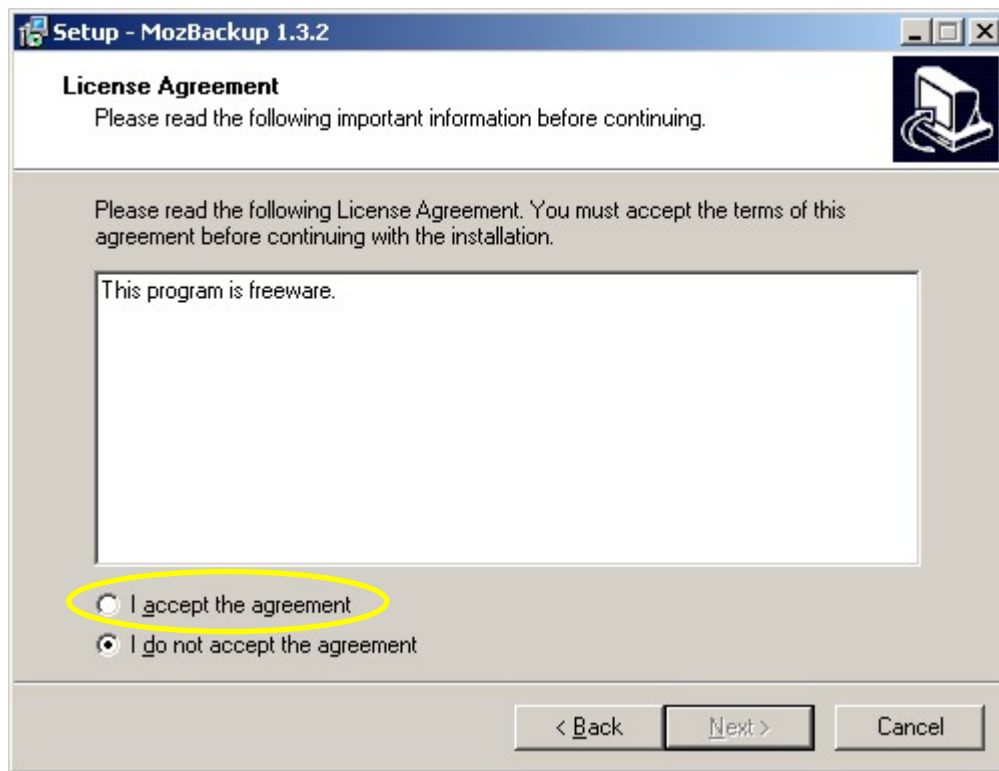


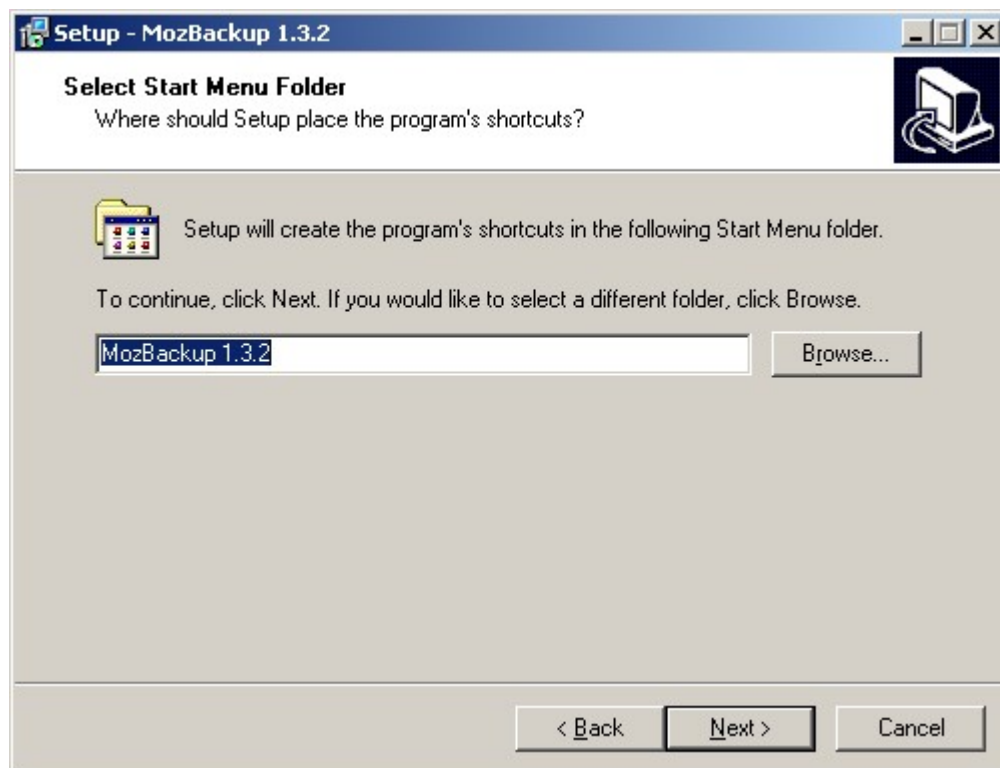
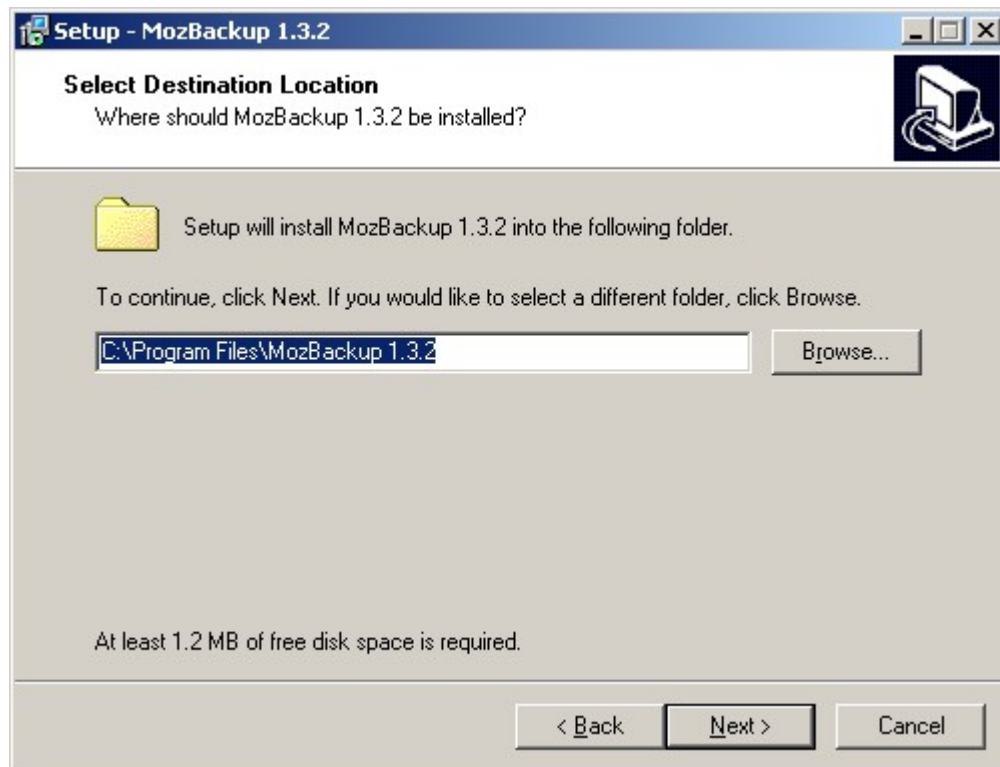
## MozBackup 1.3.2 Installation



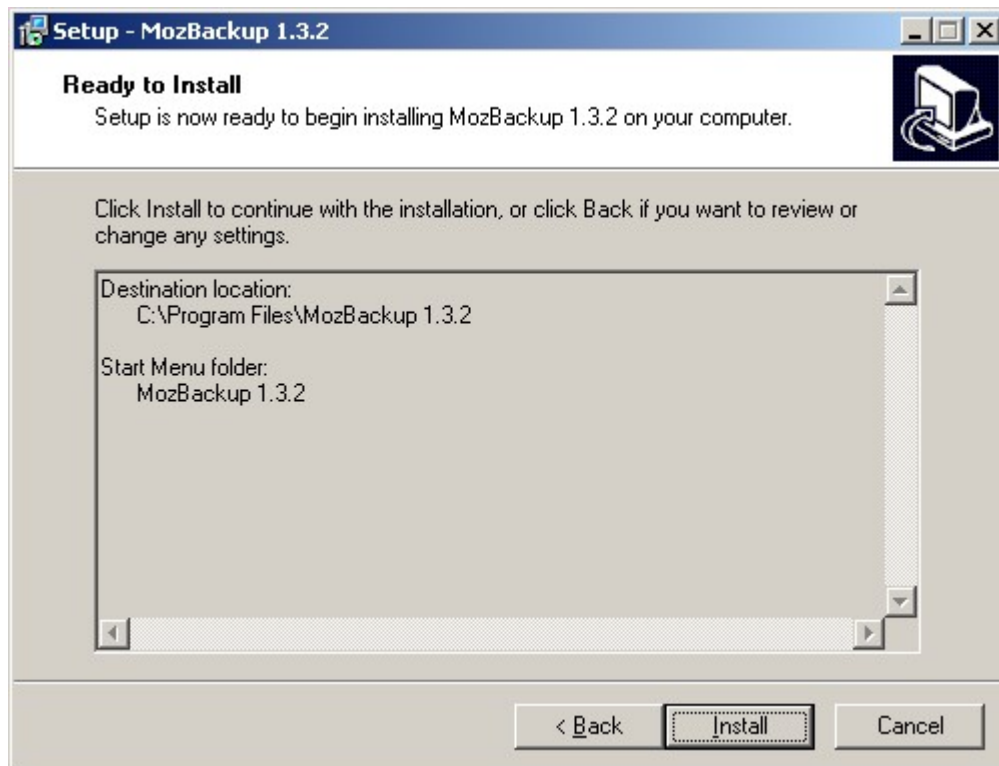
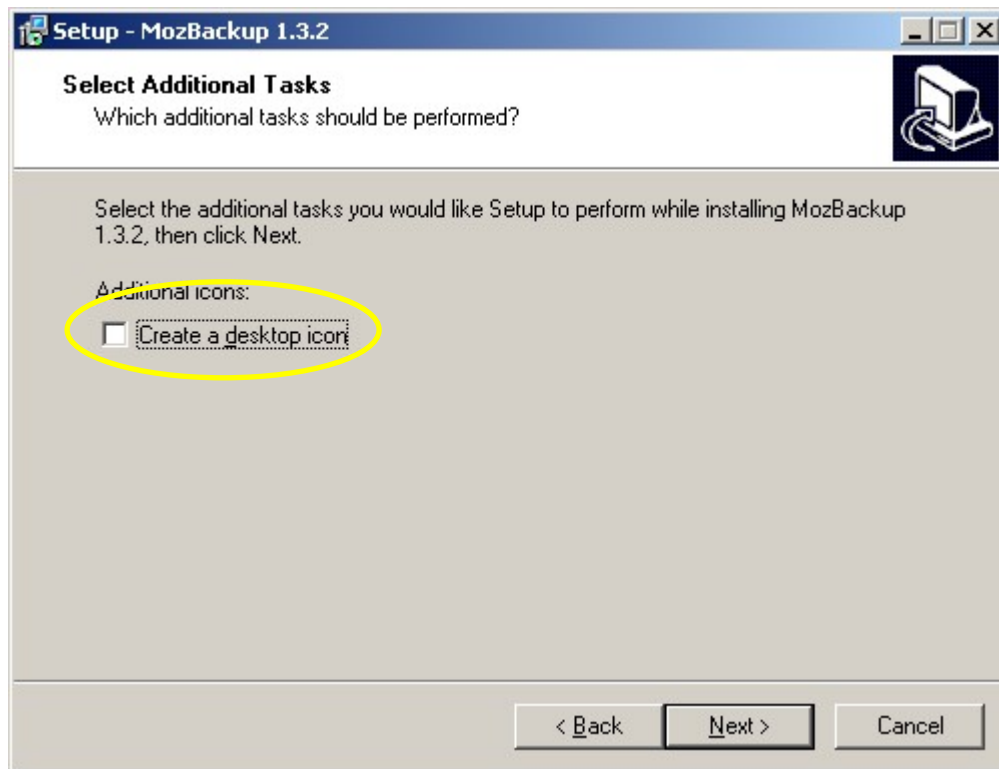
Click on the “I acept the agreement” radio button.



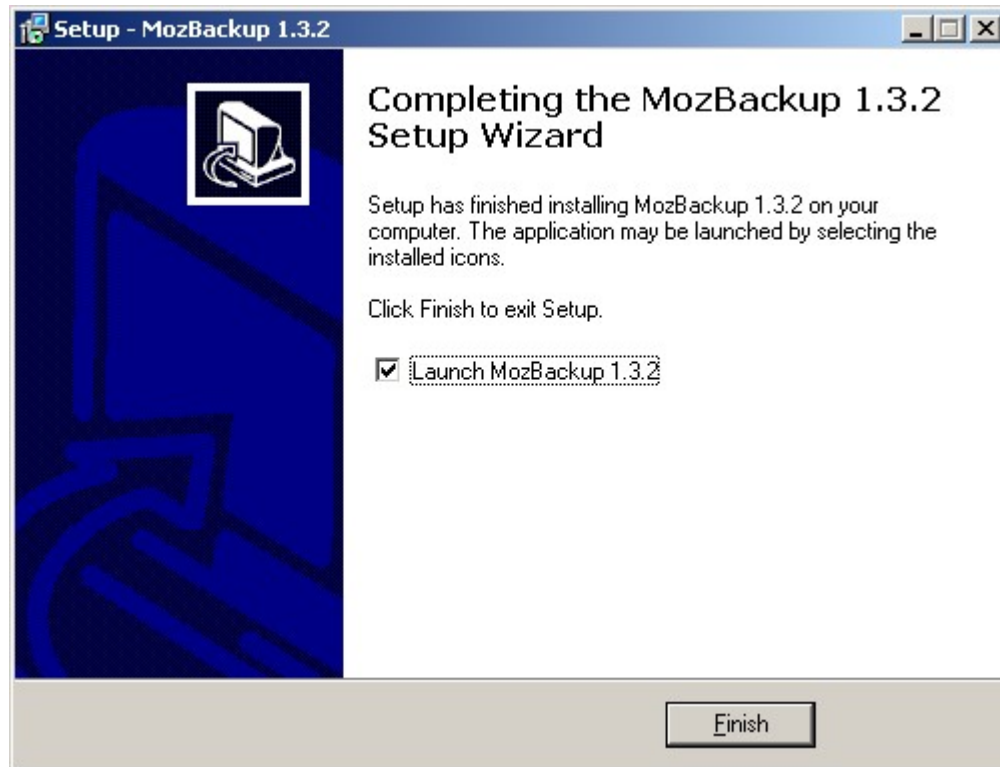
Select the location of where to install the program.



If you don't want a shortcut on the Desktop, uncheck the "Create a desktop icon" box.

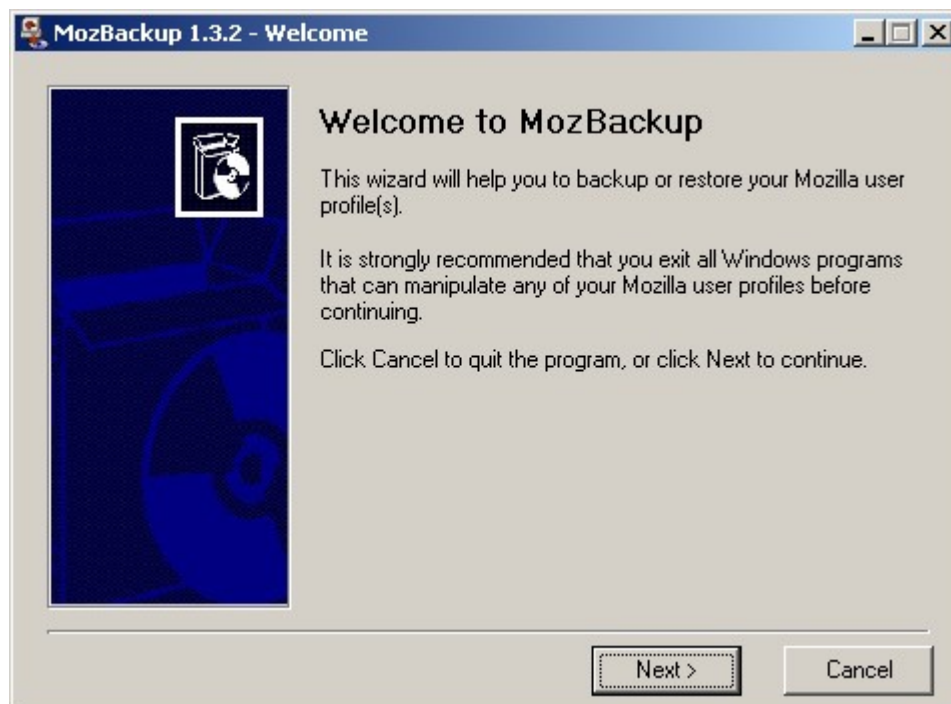


If you wish to run MozBackup directly after installation, leave this checked.  
Click the Finish button.

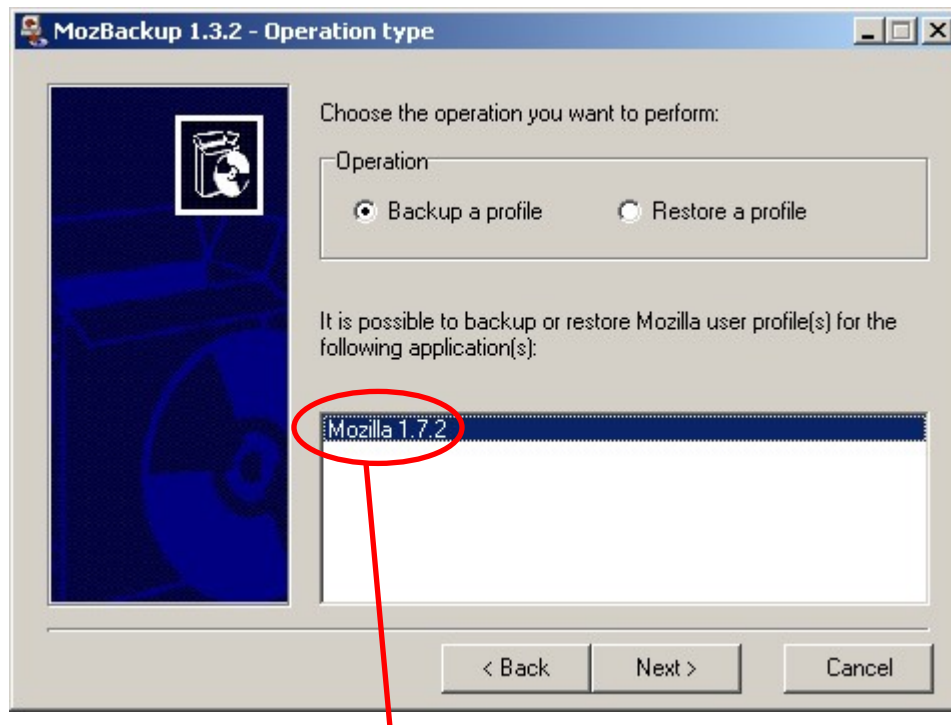

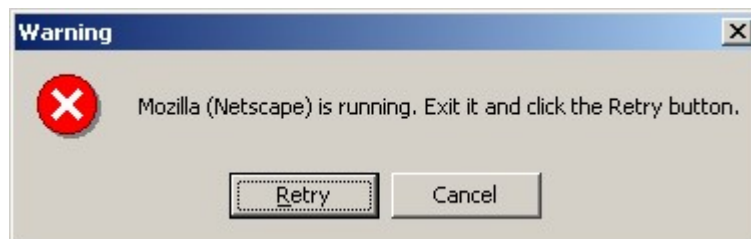


Click on the browser ID.

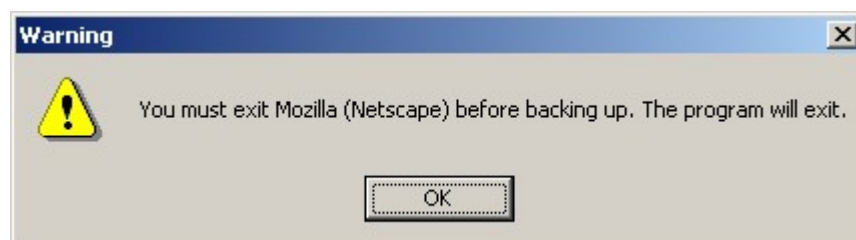


Same as Netscape 1.7.x

If Netscape is currently running, you will get this error:

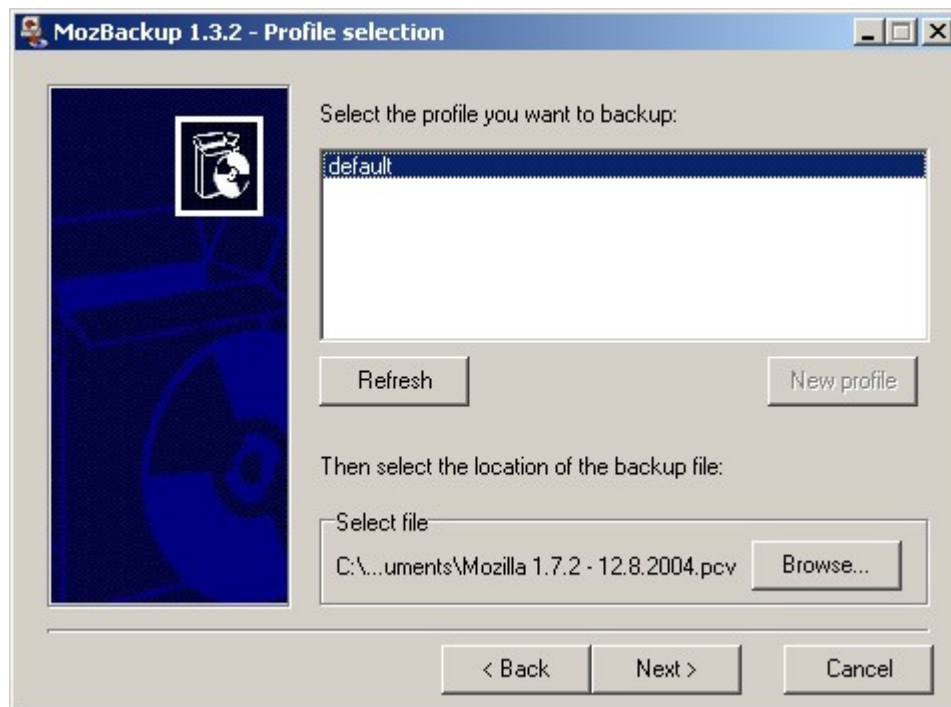


And if you press the Cancel button on this pop-up, you will get the following pop-up:

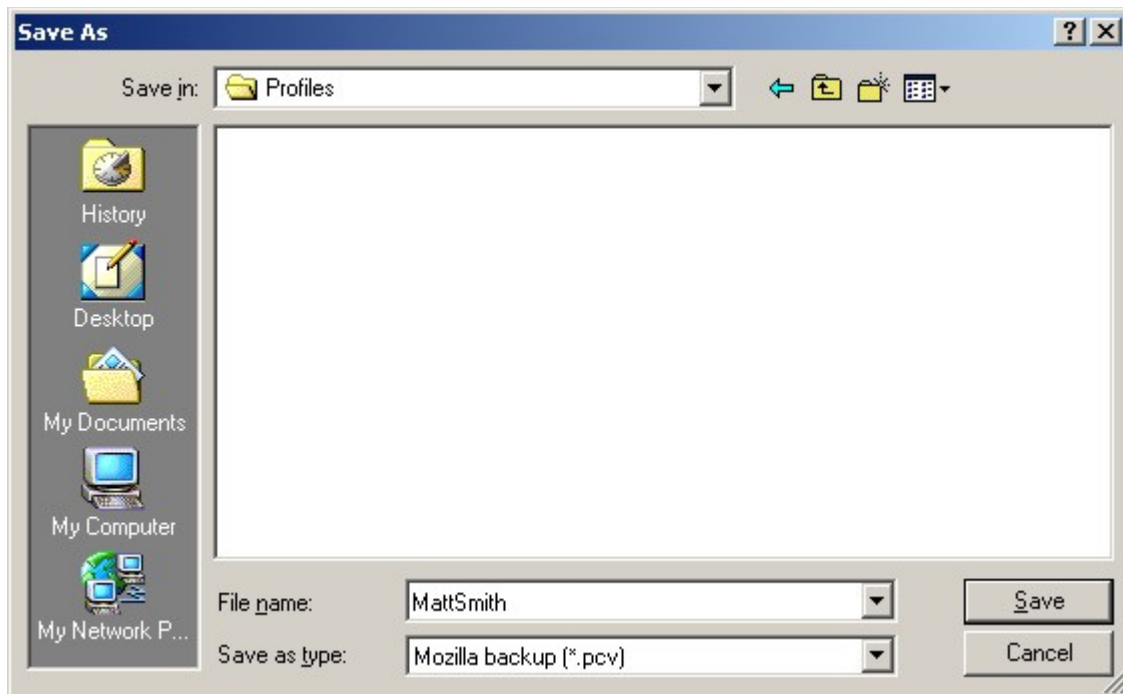


Select the profile to backup.

Click the Browse button to select a location to backup the profiles if you want it somewhere other than the default location. For this example, a directory called “C:\Profiles” was used.



Click the Save button.



You will be prompted to encrypt the file.  
Select No if you want it in an easily decipherable format. **YES** is strongly recommended.



You now have the option of choosing what to backup.





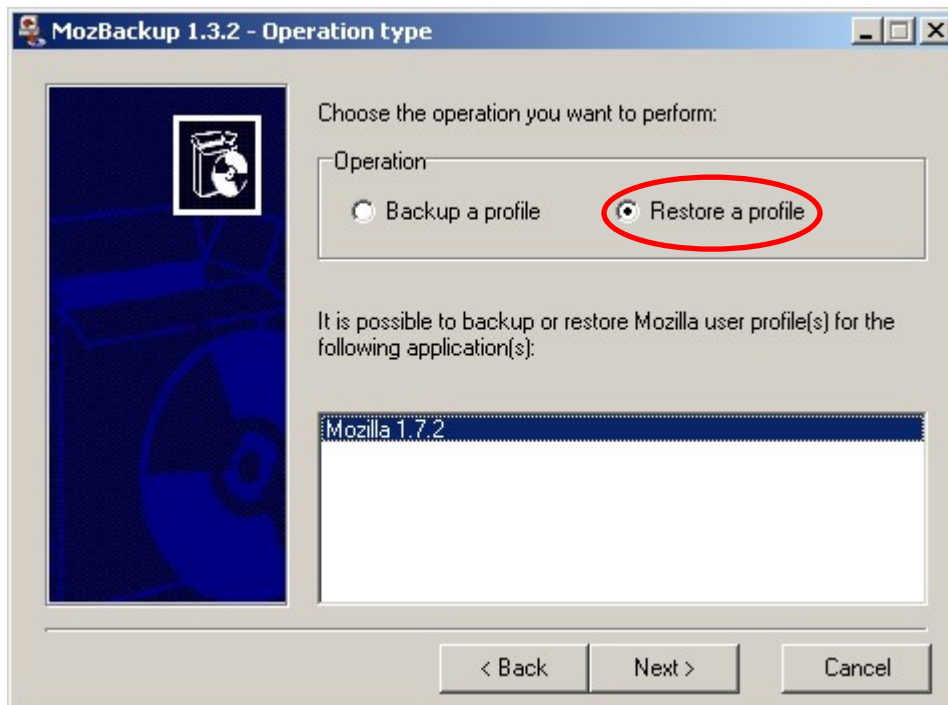
After running, if the backup was successful, you will see the following screen:



Click Finish.



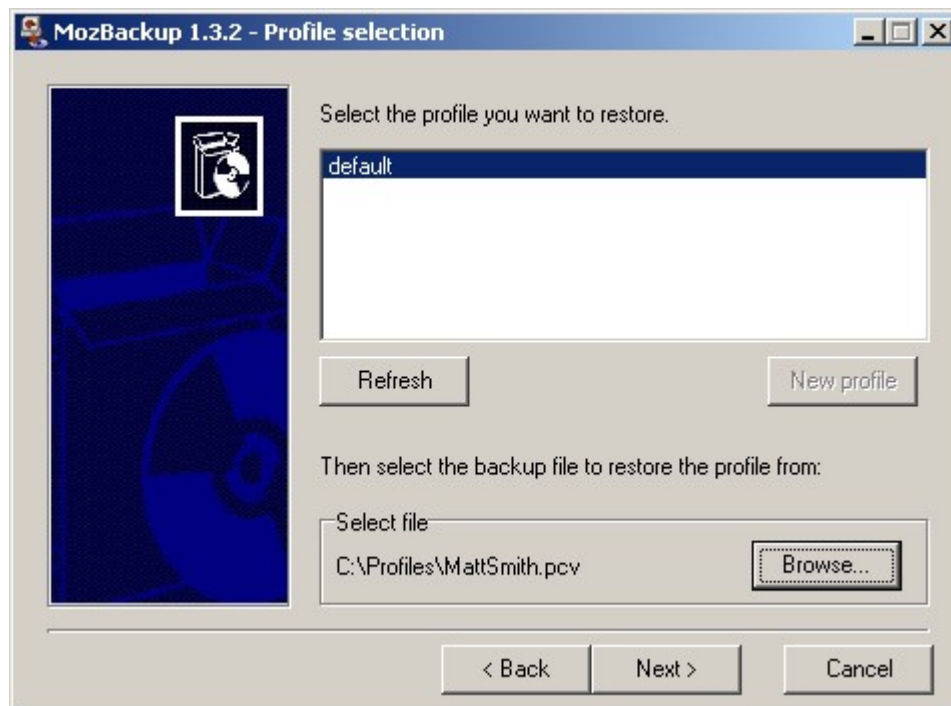
## Profile restore:



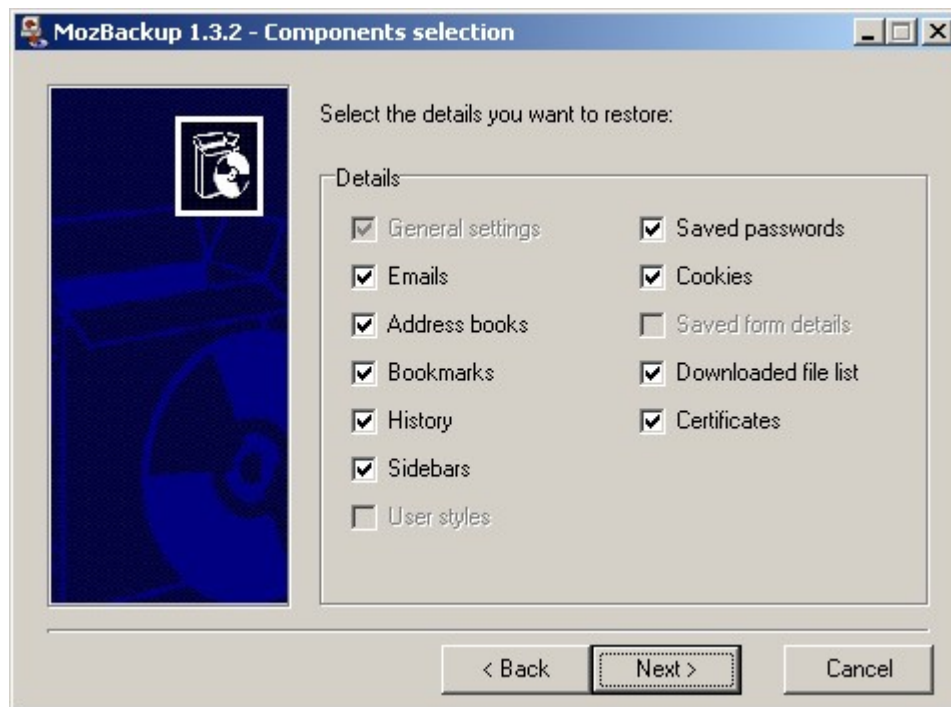
Select the profile to restore.

Click the Browse button to browse to the location where you stored the profile backup.

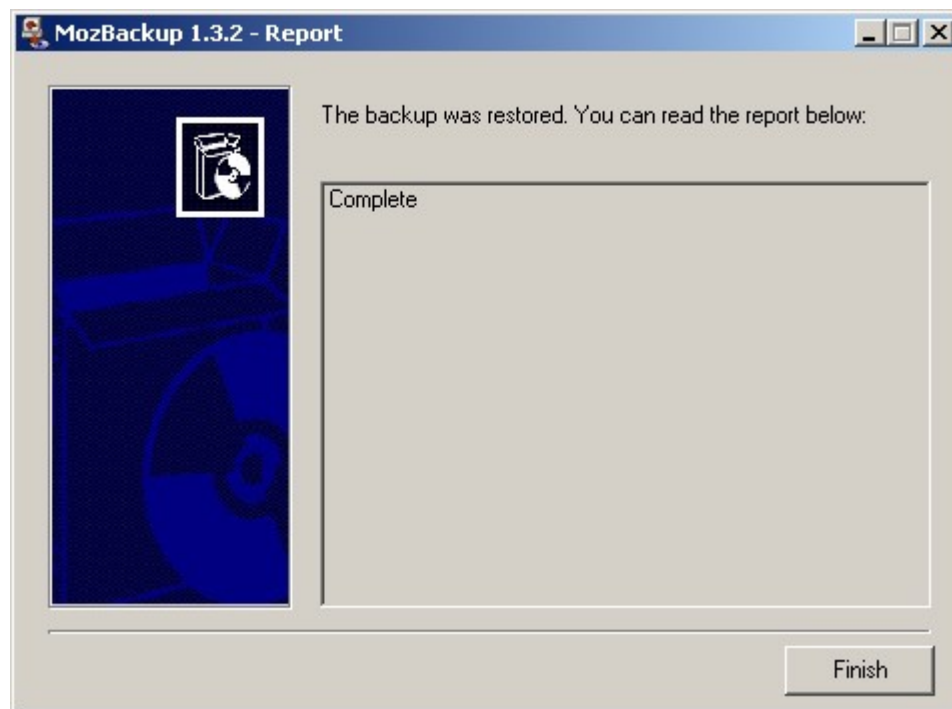
Select the profile to restore from the list.
